The Crease Street Garden is, as most know, leased from Mike and Meaghan Kind. The lease runs through August 2026. At Mike and Meaghan's invitation, the Garden Board is investigating the prospects of buying the land. Were this to come-about, the title to the land would likely be held by Neighborhood Gardens Trust, (NGT), an organization affiliated with the Pennsylvania Horticultural Society. NGT has considerable experience with small gardens, such as the Crease Street Garden. While the expectation is NGT would serve largely as an absentee landlord, in the event local management waned, NGT would serve as a 'fall back' manager. In addition, since NGT would hold title to the land, the Garden would be preserved in perpetuity (or at least as long as one could reasonably foresee).

On Thursday October 8th, 2020, 5:00 PM, two representatives of NGT (Jennifer Greenberg and Marlana Moore) will visit the Crease Street Garden and would be happy to meet all who are supportive of the long-term preservation of the Garden. **Masks are required.**
